STANDING REPORTS

Ellwood – Dale Connors 3rd Quarter 2018 Performance Update

Mr. Connors presented the $2018\ 3^{rd}$ Quarter Performance on the Adams County Retirement Plan. He stated that the markets were in negative territory through the first 3 quarters. Mr. Connors indicated that the S&P 500 was up 10.6%, non US down 1.4%, emerging markets down 7.7% and bonds down 1.6%. He stated that emerging markets entered into a bear market on September 6, 2018 when it posted a 20% decline from its late-January

peak level. This decline is largely a result of the US dollar strength which put pressure on countries that rely on foreign debt and a sell-off in Chinese internet companies. Mr. Connors continued to go through each money manager with the Board.

Private Equity – Venture Capital Update

Mr. Connors reminded the Board that the Plan has a commitment in Crestview Partners – Private Equity (Buyout). He stated that an opportunity has come up for a commitment in the Private Equity (Venture Capital). Mr. Connors brought two candidates for the Board to review Greenspring Global Partners IX and Horsley Bridge XIII Venture. He stated that Greenspring is closing mid December 2018 and Horsley Bridge sometime in 2019.

Mr. Connors indicated that Ellwood is recommending hiring Greenspring Global Partners for their Private Equity Venture Capital money manager. After some discussion the Board decided to hire Greenspring Global Partners.

Mr. Dahlman moved to hire Greenspring Global Partners # 9 Delaware fund with a commitment of \$5.75 million subject to legal review. Mr. Morgen seconded the motion it was unanimously carried.

Davis Graham & Stubbs Legal Information Updates

Ms. Birley indicated that Davis Graham & Stubbs are working on the Plan Amendment & Restatement for the Adams County Retirement Plan and a possible resolution on the lost participants. She will be bringing these items to the December 2018 Board meeting. Ms. Birley reminded the Board that December is usually when the government issues guidance so DGS will be watching for any items that may affect the Plan.
